# For the Historians...

## THE BLACK DIAMOND CUP

**This is the Oldest Sporting Trophy in Australia.**

This very fine trophy, which becomes the "loaned" property of the Newcastle Australian Football League's Premier Club each year, is the oldest sporting trophy still competed for in Australia.

In 1887, the Richmond Tobacco Company donated to the then Northern Districts Football Association a challenge cup which was to be named "The Black Diamond Cup", the name synonymous with the chief livelihood of those days within the district - coal mining - and a famous hotel - The Black Diamond Hotel. The cup was for the Australian Rules Premiership, Australia & New Zealand wide, and was for competition on a knock out basis by teams in Australia & New Zealand - where Australian Rules was also played last century, but was later superseded by Rugby Union.

The Cup was won by the powerful Wallsend team in 1889 when they beat the Victorian Club Fitzroy in the final, and as the Northern District Football Association went into recession that year - "The Cup" was entrusted to the President of the League (and the team manager of the Wallsend team) Mr. H. Rushton. When Mr. H. Rushton died, it passed to his son, Mr. G. Rushton, of Wallsend. Mr. H. Rushtons' will directed that 'The Cup' was to be made available for competition if the game was to be revived in the Newcastle area. "The Cup" was handed over to the Newcastle League in 1948, when the league was revived as a competition after the 2nd World War, by Mr. W. Rushton, whose family still held it, and it was adopted as the League 1st Grade Premiership Trophy.

# The Big Match...

Today's Grand Final brings together the consistent Warners Bay team — Grand Finalists in 5 of the last 6 seasons, and the Wallsend "Swans" — a team whose determination to win is unquestioned.

Both teams rely on overall team-work, rather than relying on the brilliance of one or two outstanding players.

In reaching the Grand Final from 4th spot and coming from behind in both the 1st Semi-final and the Preliminary final, Wallsend have displayed the determination needed to take out the "Big One." A win to the Swans would be a "first" for the Club this century.

On the other hand, Warners Bay have taken out the 1989 minor premiership with consistent performances all year and because of this consistency, have claimed a place in today's decider.

It remains to be seen if Warners Bay's rest has been beneficial to team match fitness, having played only two of the last four weekends. Where as Wallsend has played right through the final series.

It is my belief that nothing can replace match play and for this reason I tip Wallsend to record a narrow win in what could be one of the closest and most entertaining Grand Finals in recent years.

Ken Pace, who has presented the Australian Rules segment each Saturday afternoon on 2HD this season has the following comment to make about the "Big Match."

"Can Wallsend come from fourth spot to win the flag? After coming from behind to beat West in a cliff hanger, and then backing up to beat Nelson Bay in similar style, can they beat the experienced Warners Bay outfit. I don't think so!! Reigning premiers Warners Bay will not give up their title easily. They have match winners all over the ground and a desperate attitude that will prove too much for Wallsend."
